# **Character Traits**

**Becoming Analyzing Readers** 

Watch your thoughts; they become words.

Watch your words; they become actions.

Watch your actions; they become habits.

Watch your habits; they become your character.

Watch your character; it becomes your destiny.

### What is a Character Trait?

- A word to describe a person
- Not a physical trait which describes a person's physical features (the way they look) or their abilities. Example: tall
- A character trait focuses on a person's personality or demeanor (the way they act). Example: funny

# How Does Analyzing Character Traits Help You Become a Better Reader?

- When you are able to identify a character's s traits, you are able to understand their actions and motives.
- You can make predictions about how a character will react to different situations.
- Understanding the character gives you an understanding of the story.

### How to Determine Traits

- Try to identify permanent traits and not just a temporary emotion that goes against a person's normal character makeup.
- A good rule of thumb is to identify traits that you can supply plenty of examples and not just one.

# Is It Easy?

- Not hard with a little thought.
- Characters are an important element of story.
- The traits of a character can be stated or can be shown to the reader by the character's actions. (Direct or Indirect Characterization)

# For Example

- When you are reading a story the author may tell you the character is a generous person.
- The author may also show you that the character is generous by telling about a time he/she acted generously.

# 4 Ways to identify a Character's Traits in a Story

- How others feel about the character or how the character feels about themselves. F = Feelings
- 2. What the character does A = Actions
- What the character says and what others say and about the character S= Says
- 4. What the character thinks T = Thoughts

### **FAST CHART**

### Feelings-

The character's feelings or other characters' feelings about the character

### **Actions-**

What the character does.

### Says-

What the character says or what others say about the character - dialogue

### **Thoughts** -

What the character thinks about themself or what other characters think about them.











